CHANNEL 1A – RE-CONSTRUCTION

Richard Fraze, Executive Director stated that Keystone Excavators have started construction. Mike Smith, CDM stated that progress is being made after some difficulties with soil moisture. Keystone Excavators have been able to work around that issue. There is an issue with an owner's pool that is on the easement. The owner was contacted today with an offer which has the owner remove the pool from the easement. Richard Fraze, Executive Director stated that a One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000) authorization was given for the owner of the pool to remove the pool and sign the temporary construction easement that is presently needed.

CHANNEL 1-A-2 (MCKIM & CREED)

SWFWMD is indicating that a letter along with a sketch may be sufficient and McKim & Creed is trying to have SWFWMD to get an exemption of the environments resource permit and the second item would be to get reinforced concrete approval instead of Fabriform material.

CHANNEL 2 - CULVERT UPGRADES - GANDY BLVD.

Richard Fraze, Executive Director stated that a meeting was held with Tom Gibson, City of St. Petersburg on February 6, 2008 in referencing working together on the contraction phase. A meeting was held also with FDOT and a meeting is scheduled for next Wednesday, February 27, 2008 with SWFWMD.

CHANNEL 4A – PHASE 3 – 53RD STREET TO 62ND AVE.

Mike Smith, CDM stated the design is ready to go. Easement issues are being reviewed as it appears one resident has hired an attorney. Tom Tripp, District Attorney explained the difference on the easements on this project compared to easements with high banks and the working within the easements. This project is outside of the normal easement. A review is in place to see how best to proceed with the easement.

a) Michael Farrell – Reappointment Issues

Richard Fraze, Executive Director informed the Board members that the Pinellas County Board of Commissioners had reinstated Michael Farrell to a three (3) period and that Commissioner John Morroni will serve as the liaison between the Pinellas County Commission and the District.

b) Representative Janet Long

Richard Fraze, Executive Director informed the Board that several conversations have been held with Representative Janet Long and it appears she is not real adversarial anymore. The audit of the District will be taking place per her request. There also appears to be some sort of mind set in Tallahassee to blame the problems of high taxes on the special districts. Representative Rick Kriseman has proposed a bill that would require codification of all special districts #HB795.

c) Resolution – Engineer Week

Daniel Glaser representing the Professional Engineers read Resolution #08-01 proclaiming Professional Engineers Week within the District. Mr. Farrell made the motion to approve Resolution #08-01. Second was made by Mr. Taylor.

d) Workers Compensation Claim – Albert Ferguson

e) Replacement of Executive Director

Richard Fraze, Executive Director stated that a decision needed to be made on the hiring of a District Engineer. Michael Gustafson, City Manager, Pinellas Park, stated that in an effort to help with expenses both for the City of Pinellas Park and the District that the combined effort of using the City of Pinellas Park Engineer may be an option. Board member, Ed Taylor explained the Kenneth City model shows that two governmental agencies work together. A lengthy discussion was held on hiring a District Engineer, promoting from within for Executive Director, or going outside of the District for an Engineer and/or Executive Director. Tom Tripp, District Attorney was requested to look into any legal aspects of the City of Pinellas Park offering engineering services. Richard Fraze, Executive Director suggested that a discussion be held with the City of Pinellas Park and himself on their proposal and the City of Pinellas Park is then to present at the next regular authority meeting their proposal to assist the District. A motion was made by Michael Farrell to form a committee of three (3) Tom Tripp, District Attorney, Charles Tingler, Chairman of the Board and Chip Herom, CDM to review the three (3) qualified applicants and make a recommendation for a District Engineer.
