CHANNEL 1A – RENEWAL FROM 47TH ST. TO 56TH. ST.

CHANNEL 1B5C - RENEWAL & STRUCTURAL REPLACEMENT

Mike Smith, District Engineer, stated the past month the District Engineer approved the preliminary design. The engineers researched, without success, for previous permit information from SWFWMD on the basin that feeds into the culvert as the project is changing the ditch into a culverted pipe; CDMSmith was able to obtain storm sewer improvements drawings from the City of Pinellas Park for 82nd Ave. N and have been reviewed. The District will be moving along with the project.
